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Dear Festival Vendor:

Thank you for deciding to participate in the Caribbean Festival annual event. Each vendor must obtain the proper permits and licenses and have them in their possession the day of the festival for Health Officer Inspection. Please note, Solano County is one of the stricter county's for Health Inspection. Be sure to read all attached paperwork thoroughly.

The following information is required of each vendor:

- **Health Permit**: Food vendors are required to obtain a Health Permit from the Solano County Health Department and must provide a copy of the Permit to Caribbean Festival immediately.
- **Business License**: All vendors are required to be fully licensed to conduct business. All vendors must have a valid business resale license.
- **Staff**: Please submit a list of staff that will be working your booth. The limit for food vendors is four (4) including yourself. For clothing and miscellaneous vendors the limit is three (3) including yourself. Persons not on the list will not be allowed on the grounds for set-up or entrance.
